2023 Rosato



The "Alpine" range are value wines made to offer immediate enjoyment to the consumer. The range is made up of a Bianco, Rosato, Rosso, Prosecco and Sparkling Red. Components vary year to year depending on the season and careful blending is used to create interesting wines featuring an abundance of varieties. Even though this range is made on a slightly larger scale than other Billy Button wines, all the components are made using a small batch ethos and are kept separate until the final blending.

The 2023 Rosato is 100% Sangiovese, sourced from Ferraro Vineyards in Mytleford.

Production Notes

Machine harvested, crushed and pressed to stainless steel. The juice was cold settled before being racked and divided into several batches. Each tank was inoculated with a different selected yeast, was fermented between 13 and 15 degrees and sulphured on completion of ferment to retain freshness. The wine was then allowed some time on yeast lees before blending and clarification. Bottled June 2023.

Tasting Notes

Pale salmon in colour. Lifted aromas of red berry fruits and underlying savoury elements reministent of kitchen herbs. Flavours of vibrant red fruits are enhanced by salivating acid and a textural, dry, savoury finish.
