

2022 Rosso

The blended range are value wines made to offer immediate enjoyment to the consumer. The range is made up of a Bianco, Rosato, Rosso and Prosecco. Components vary year to year depending on the season and careful blending is used to create interesting wines featuring an abundance of varieties. Even though this range is made on a slightly larger scale than other Billy Button wines, all the components are made using a small batch ethos and are kept separate until the final blending.

Production Notes

A delicious blend of Shiraz, Tempranillo and Refosco. All components were fermented separately in open tubs and hand plunged. A combination of selected yeast and wild yeast were used across the different components. Each batch was pressed directly to a variety of vessels, including old oak, stainless steel and Flexcubes, for malolactic fermentation and maturation. Components were kept separate until blending and filtration. Bottled November 2022.

Tasting Notes

Lifted aromas of rhubarb and red plums are complemented by subtle hints of warm spice. Savoury notes on the palate balance out the ripe, red fruits. Full, soft tannins offer level of complexity and deliver a wine of great length.
