pinot noir



Appellation: Bourgogne Pinot Noir

Grape variety: Pinot Noir

Surface area: 1.3407 hectares

Average age of vines: 65 years

Terroir: northern exposure, slight slope, clay-limestone soil, fresh and deep

Places: Les Foulrières, Les Platinières, La Motte sur Chat

Vintage: 2022

Small grapes, lots of millerandage in these old vines.

Harvest: manual harvest on September 11, 2022

Vinification: 1/3 whole harvest and 2/3 destemmed grapes, traditional fermentation and maceration in concrete tanks for 18 days with daily pumping over and 5 punching downs.

Aging: in 228 l barrels, in French oak for 9 months (30% new barrels). Racking and blending in stainless steel vats for 1 month.

Bottling: July 18, 2023

Production: 5,600 bottles

Tasting notes: The violet hue of this Burgundy and its lovely notes of dark fruits (cherry, blackcurrant) offer a rich density and aromatic complexity on the palate. The toasted oak from aging is present, and the tannins are finely crafted. It's a wine that is both taut and well-structured.
