

Located in the northern part of the Rhône Valley, in the historic heart of the Saint Joseph appellation, the domain made its first harvest in 2014. After several years of experience in France and abroad, Bastien Jolivet decides to return to the family exploitation and to partner with his father. They stopped selling the grapes to make their own wine. The vineyard is planted on a hillside facing South / South-East with many stone walls. These granite soils are ideal for Syrah to express itself fully. The work in the vineyard is carried out almost entirely by hand.
