

2024 DUNE MASPALOMAS



DUNE Maspalomas is a blend of red and white grapes together — Grenache Noir and Grenache Blanc.

Hand-picked and co-fermented on skins, akin to a very light red wine, a beautiful floral rose nose, with poached strawberry and white pepper. The palate is mid-weight with lovely chalky tannins, and flavours of blood orange, rasperry and aromatic herbs.

Drink it chilled, not super cold but in the fridge for an hour before serving is best.

Comp: 50% Grenache Noir, 50% Grenache Blanc Region: Blewitt Springs sub—region, McLaren Vale

Alc: 12.5% pH: 3.51 TA: 5.58 g/L

VINTAGE 2024

Vine growth started relatively early with cool but sunny and dry conditions, followed by a dramatic change from mid-November 2023 to mid-January 2024. Wind and rain dictated the summer period, all irrigation was stopped and canopy trimming and leaf plucking was required to ensure sufficient light onto fruit for ripening. In late January, the rain stopped and we had a prolonged dry and warm weather pattern including a mini-heatwave in March. With the wetter summer and bigger canopies, the whites are showing bright acidity and pure fruit flavours. Our red varieties all performed well with nice even crops showing great fragrance and purity.
