Vines in shallow soil, well exposed slopes of pebbly marl producing rich wines, tight and harmonious.

Origins of the lieu-dit: «Caille» is a dialect word meaning «caillou/caillouteux» (pebble/pebbly); the suffix «-ret» is a Burgundian diminutive.
