2023 Old Hill 1880 Vines Shiraz

First planted by Charles King in 1880, the Old Hill is one of the Hunter Valleys most prestigious vineyards. The source of cuttings for many of the most famous vineyards in the area, the site is ideal for Shiraz grapes. Acquiring the morning sun and sheltered from the afternoon heat, these vines produce exceptional grapes year in and year out.

Tasting Notes

Deep purple in colour, a perfumed nose of pure shiraz, intense red fruits, spice, and liquorice, with a beautiful medium bodied palate rich in flavour and fine, perfectly structured tannins.

Drinking Window

This wine has the freshness to drink young, and the pedigree and chemistry to age gracefully over the next 50 years.
