1946 Vines Rosehill Shiraz

Purchased in 1945 and planted by Maurice O'Shea in 1946, the Creek block as it is called, produces an amazing and unique perspective of Shiraz. Planted from different stock than the Old Vines off Mount Pleasant Estate, the intense floral aromatics are a signature of this Rosehill vineyard.

Aroma

Fresh dark red fruits with exquisite spice and unique violets which can only come from this impressive vineyard.

Palate

Intense and structural, classically medium bodied with delightful acidity and devastating length.

Vinification/Maturation

Picked over 4 days from the top to the bottom and fermented separately, with one parcel utilizing around 15% whole bunches. A short cold soak and fermentation time, before pressing to tank and transfer to large format French oak at less than 20% new. After 12 months the wine was blended and bottled.
