ADELAIDE HILLS - PINOT NOIR 2025



THE STORY

A man named Georges Fesq once travelled as a supercargo, selecting and selling wine at every port of call. Arriving in Sydney in 1848, he chose to stay, founding Fesq & Company. Supercargo is a modern tribute to this tradition of curating exceptional wines.

TASTING NOTES

A youthful, energetic red that's just as happy with a slight chill as it is at room temp. The nose is immediately inviting, layering bright fruit with subtle flickers of liquorice and cool mint.

The palate shows lifted cherry and strawberry with subtle spice, crunchy blueberries, red apples, and snappy cherries lead the charge, backed by a sophisticated savoury edge of twigs, earth, and dried herbs. A touch of dark chocolate rounds out the smooth finish, keeping the wine perfectly balanced and approachable. It's a neat, high-value package that over-delivers on personality.

WINE DETAILS

2025 was a warm, dry and early vintage resulting in great concentration, pure, and structured wines. Single vineyard, picked in late March.

Cold soaked for up to 48 hours. Whole bunch grapes added to fermentation.

Matured in barrel for 7 to 9 months. (Mixture of 225, 300 and 500 litres barrels french oak)
